Wisdom Works is a coaching and consulting firm that develops the skills of 21st Century Leaders to manage complexity, think holistically, gain competitiveness through collaboration, and produce inspired, sustainable results. We believe that the future of business is in holistic minded leaders who understand the connection between *healthy leader, healthy business and healthy world*. This scholarship is directed toward students interested in studying sustainable leadership development in fields such as education, business and politics. This scholarship is an opportunity for budding leaders to be introduced to the concepts of 21st Century leadership and stimulate their thoughts around business and leadership practices as agents of global transformation.

Wisdom Scholars will receive an award of \$2,000 for one academic year with four equal disbursements. The first installment of \$500 will be sent by August 6th. The second and third installments shall come after the scholars complete their written article review each semester, as explained below. The final installment will be awarded at completion of the Spring Term.

Each wisdom scholar is required to read an article sent to them by Wisdom Works and submit a written review (no more than 2 pages in length). The written review is due by the 2nd week of November for Fall Term and the 2nd week of April for the Spring Term. The article review will describe their experience of the article and how it fits in with or contrasts to their course work.

Interested students must complete the Wisdom Scholars application and submit two letters of recommendation and a copy of their college transcript. Students must have a grade point average of 2.5 or better. Applications are accepted through April 15th with award notification of May 15th.
